Within the scope of the FIA Environmental Sustainability Framework, WRC Safari Rally Kenya takes on the environmental commitment as the organizer of this event. Our shared responsibility and commitment to actively reduce the event's impact on the environment is shared across the board.

For this, we call upon all our stakeholders, ranging from the organizers, competitors, sponsors, suppliers and members of the public to share in our commitment to reduce the environmental impacts caused by the event.

This will be guided by the following targets:

- Commit to a more rational, efficient and environmentally adequate use of the resources available, in
 the practices necessary to carry out the event, with the aim of promoting sustainability and reducing
 the ecological footprint;
- <u>Communicate environmental commitment</u> to participants, suppliers, sponsors and the public to enhance stakeholder awareness;
- Integrate the consideration of environmental concerns and impacts into all strategic decision making and activities;
- o <u>Minimize waste generation</u> and where possible, reuse or recycle as much of it as is possible;
- Reduce as far as possible the environmental impact of transport by encouraging the use of public transport and carpooling where possible.
- o <u>Train</u>, educate and inform stakeholders about relevant environmental issues;

THESE WILL BE ACHIEVED THROUGH THE FOLLOWING SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- o <u>Respect all environmental laws and regulations</u> and other requirements, as well as the FIA Environmental Certification Framework;
- o <u>Ensure full commitment at senior management level</u> and responsibilities for environmental and sustainability objectives are assigned throughout the organization;
- Work closely with the local authorities and environmental agencies in the rally crossing areas in order
 to assess and reduce the impacts that might be generated by the event as much as possible;
- Oblige the teams to put a sufficiently large and tight plastic ground sheet under the cars in order to carry out service and mechanical work on the cars, to collect any polluting agent and to avoid it from getting in touch with the ground;
- o To install in the Service Park and spectator areas <u>labelled and color-coded bins</u> for different types of waste to allow for proper waste segregation and management;
- The waste management company must comply with the specifications of the necessary environmental
 certifications for the environment-friendly management of waste.
